## ANSWERS to Catholic IQ from page 28

**1. a)** Church catechisms have used the Ten Commandments to teach morality (*CCC*, 2065).

**2.** d) In Greek, *decalogue* means the "ten words." For Jews and Christians, it means "a basic set of authoritative rules that are binding to believers" (see *CCC*, 2068).

**3.** c) I am the Lord thy God; thou shalt not have strange gods before me (CCC, 2110). All Christians believe in one God but understand that one God to be a Trinity — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

**4. b**) Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor. A person has a right to their good name and reputation (see *CCC*, 2479).

**5. d)** "Lying is the most direct offense against the truth. To lie is to speak or act against the truth in order to lead someone into error. The Lord denounces lying as the work of the devil" (*CCC*, 2483).

**6. True.** As with all mortal sins, however, a person must knowingly and willfully commit this sin.

7. d) To covet means to desire what is not yours. David desired Bathsheba, which led him to steal Uriah's wife, commit adultery with her, lie about it, and eventually kill Uriah to try to cover up the sin.

**8. c)** The Old Testament tells the story of the Jewish people from the creation of the world until the years before the birth of Christ.

**9. a)** For the Israelites, the Ark of the Covenant carried the evidence that God was with them. Besides the tablets, the Ark contained manna from the desert and Aaron's staff (see Hebrews 9:4; *cf. CCC*, 2058).

**10. b)** *Thou shalt not kill.* Since an unborn baby is a living human being, to

abort him/her is murder (see CCC, 2271).

**11. False.** The first three refer to God, and the last seven speak to relationships with others.

**12. a)** The Ten Commandments gave the Israelites concrete guidelines on how to live as God's chosen people.

**13. d**) Jesus said: "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. ... You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Matthew 22:37, 39).

**14. d)** God worked miracles, including sending 10 plagues to convince the Egyptian Pharaoh to release the Israelite people from slavery after 400 years.

**15. False.** The last commandment says: *You shall not covet your neighbor's goods*. That means that we must control our thoughts so that we don't desire what is not ours.

**16.** a) Even though not explicitly stated, the Fourth Commandment includes the obligation "to honor and respect all those whom God, for our good, has vested with his authority" (*CCC*, 2197), including teachers.

**17. b)** The Church teaches that if society cannot protect itself from a killer without the death penalty, it is allowed. However, necessary executions "are very rare, if not practically nonexistent" (*CCC*, 2267) because of options such as life in prison.

**18.** a) "Someone who defends his life is not guilty of murder even if he is forced to deal his aggressor a lethal blow" (*CCC*, 2264).

**19. c)** Thou shalt not commit adultery (the Sixth Commandment) teaches that married people can only share marital intimacy with their spouse (see *CCC*, 2380-2381).

**20.** False. Jesus teaches against "anger, hatred, and vengeance." Christ asks his

disciples to turn the other cheek and to love their enemies. He did not defend himself when he was arrested and told Peter to put down his sword (see *CCC*, 2262).

**7.** b) God said, *"Keep holy the Lord's Day (the Sabbath)"* because we need time to rest, to be with our families, and to worship and thank God for how great he is.

**8.** a) *Honor your father and mother.* Even Jesus obeyed this commandment with Mary and Joseph (see Luke 2:51).

**9.** d) The last two commandments forbid covering. So we not only have to avoid bad actions such as stealing, but we need to protect our hearts and minds against desiring what others have. These desires, called envy, can make us miserable and lead us to bad actions.

**10. True**. If we hate people or want bad things to happen to them, we are, in a sense, harming them, and maybe even ourselves. Talk to a trusted adult about this subject.
