Juanita Solar was born in Chile in 1900. She had three brothers and two sisters. She liked getting together with her aunt, uncle, and cousins. It was fun to be with family. She also played the piano.

When she was 19 years old, Juanita entered the Carmelite order and took the name Sister Teresa. She lived the Gospels each day. She wrote in a letter that God was the joy of her life.

Sister Teresa became ill and died less than a year later, in 1920. She is a patron saint of young people. Her life shows us that we are called to share God's love with others in all that we do each day.
