There are three persons in the TINYRIT.

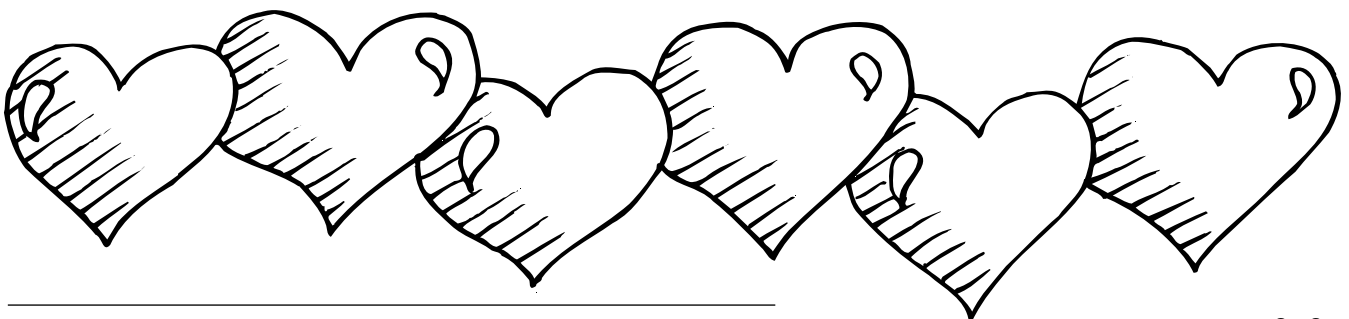
Christians believe that Jesus is the MASHIES.
