
Signing Prayer



Grace—Reach the hand out toward heaven to grab something. Then bring it to your heart.




God—Look to heaven. Point one hand upward toward God and bring the hand down to the center of your chest.



Gift—Make right angles with both pointer fingers out from the chest. Now bring this "box" toward you.

Teach students these signs, one at a time. When they have mastered all four signs, have them sign these words as they pray together.

Grace is God's gift to us. Alleluia!



Alleluia—Clap the palms of the hands together. Then "bump" two letter L's in front of your chest. Finally, bring each hand out to the side—hands are closed, then opened.
