

SAINT JOHN OF GOD

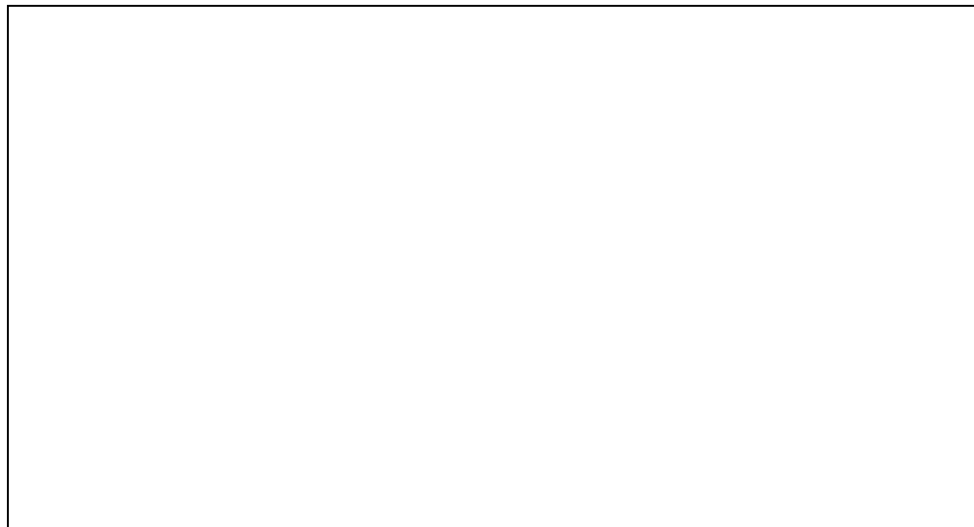
Feast Day: March 8
