Marguerite d'Youville lived in Quebec, Canada. She helped people who were sick and living in poverty. Her husband and four of her children died. She started a store to earn money to raise her two sons. Her sons eventually became priests.

She was a person of compassion. In 1747 she became the head of a Montreal hospital. She took in everyone who was sick even if they couldn't pay. She also prayed for others.

She started the Sisters of Charity of Montreal. They continue her work today. Her example shows us that we are called to love all people in Jesus' name and pray for them.
